Colds, flu and Covid are on the rise as we head into the winter months. The Ministry of Health states that:

- If you test positive for COVID-19 you must self-isolate for 7 days.
- Day 0 is the day your symptoms started or when you tested positive, <u>whichever came first</u>.
- Stay at home do not go to work, <u>school</u> or any public places.
- You cannot end your self-isolation early, even if a later test is negative during the 7 days.

It is important to keep your child/ren home from school for the full 7 days if they test positive (or until they are well again, if they are still sick after 7 days), to minimise the risk of spreading Covid.

On Tuesday we have our teacher only day. Staff will be learning to identify what causes inappropriate behaviours and how to help tamariki resettle, without adding to their stress or distress.

We will be holding Learning Conferences in week 8 of this term. This will be a chance to talk with your child and their teacher, about how they are doing at school. Teachers will write a summary of your discussion, which will become the child's mid-year report. More details, and how to book a time with your child's teacher, will follow in a separate notice.

What an amazing first half of the term we have had. We have a wonderful little school, and our tamariki are a delight to work with!
