A heartfelt thanks to scorers, supporters and transporters from Pomare's Flippaball Team. Your help assisted our enjoyment and success.

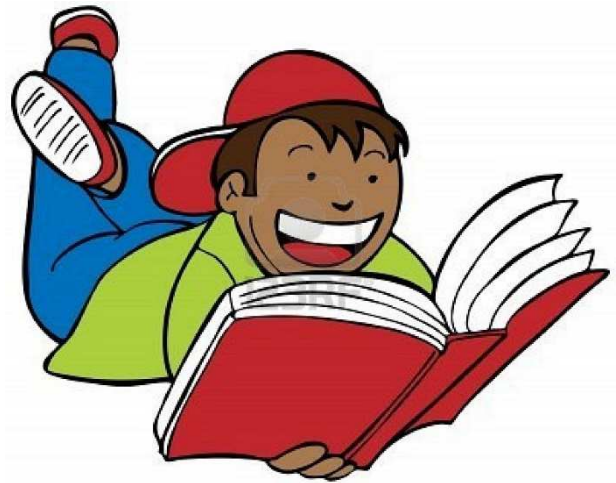
Union Meeting
