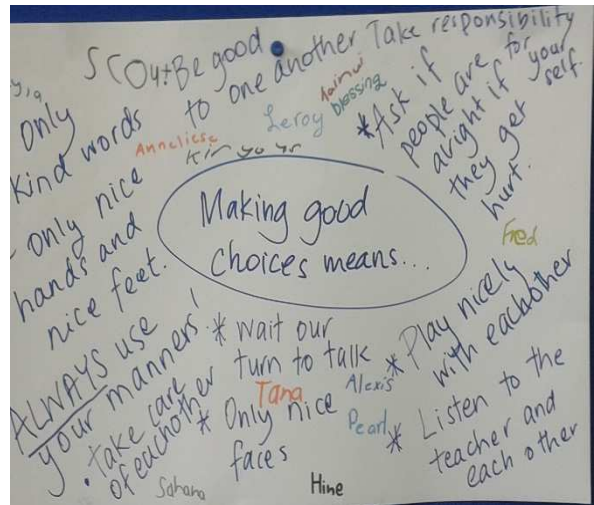


Sunhats
